We will also have a short meeting to make plans for our Bake Sale on April 12th. Please bring a sack lunch; the beverage will be provided. Look forward to seeing you there!






On Sunday, March 2, 2025 we will have a Pancake Breakfast to support Donate Life after Church. All are welcome!!
